## Program Information

OutREACH will be held **every Tuesday and Thursday from 2:15-3:35 pm beginning October 11<sup>th</sup>**. The last day of the program will be Thursday, May 18, 2017. *OutREACH will not be held during the weeks of November 7<sup>th</sup>, November 21<sup>st</sup>, December 19<sup>th</sup>, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, February 20<sup>th</sup>*, or any days that school is not in session/or if we have early dismissal.

Sessions begin promptly at 2:15. An afternoon snack will be provided to every student. Students arriving after 2:20 will not be admitted to the program and will not be able to access transportation. If students decide to leave their session before 3:35, they will not be allowed to return for the day or access transportation. Students should check in with their session leaders and get a pass if they need to work with their individual classroom teachers.
