OutREACH will be held **every Tuesday and Thursday from 2:15-3:35 pm beginning October 11<sup>th</sup>.** The last day of the program will be Thursday, May 18, 2017. *OutREACH will not be held during the weeks of November 7<sup>th</sup>, November 21<sup>st</sup>, December 19<sup>th</sup>, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, February 20<sup>th</sup>, or any days that school is not in session/or if we have early dismissal.*
