## Program Information

OutREACH Session 1 will be held **every Tuesday and Thursday from 2:20-3:30 pm beginning Nov. 2, 2017 through Thursday, January 4, 2018.** . *OutREACH will not be held during the weeks of Thanksgiving and winter breaks, or any days that school is not in session.*

Sessions begin promptly at 2:20 pm. Students are expected to stay until 3:30 and attend all 8 weeks. If a student has 3 unexcused absences, they will be removed from the program.
