- SAT/ACT decide which test is best for you
 - Take before the end of junior year (after you have completed majority of Algebra 2)
 - Register early to get good test location
- SAT Subject Tests

• AP Tests

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

- GPA is cumulative from first quarter
 9th grade through the end of 11th grade. It does not include senior year grades.
- We report weighted and unweighted
 GPA
- Official GPA is calculated around Oct 1st in all Howard County schools.

- Summer Internships




