GRADUATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. You do not have to participate in the graduation ceremony in order to receive a diploma. Parents must submit a written request for non-participation to Mr. Wasilewski by Friday, May 5, 2017.
- 2. Although participation in the graduation exercise is voluntary, attendance at all graduation practices is <u>mandatory</u> in order to participate in the exercise. You must be on time and stay for the full time.
- 3. Caps and gowns are required attire for the graduation ceremony and day awards assembly.
 - a. Seniors should wear their caps straight on their heads with the deep part at the back and the tassel over the left temple.
 - b. Some of the caps will not fit easily with all current hair fashions. Adjust your hair accordingly.
 - c. Gowns should be brought up on the shoulders in the back.
 - d. Females should wear a dress, skirt or dress pants with a blouse. Dress shoes should be worn.
 - e. Males should wear a collared dress shirt, necktie, dark colored slacks, dark shoes, and dark socks. All shirts are to be buttoned and collars should be inside the gown.
 - f. Sneakers, flip flops, boots or other such footwear will not be allowed.
- 4. When receiving your cap and gown, hang it up! Wrinkles do not come out when the gowns are left in the bags.
- 5. All Howard County Public School System policies and school rules will remain in effect and will be enforced. Please do not jeopardize your privilege to receive a diploma. Listen! Pay attention! If you do not cooperate during practice, you will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- 6. Each graduate will receive 6 graduation tickets.
- 7. In order to preserve the dignity of the occasion for each student, we ask that guests please refrain from the use of horns, balloons, beach balls, etc. and/or engage in excessive celebration.
